

FAQ'S For NEW 6th Grade Families!

- **Where does my 6th grader go Monday morning?** 6th grade homeroom is 1st period so they may go to the cafeteria for breakfast first, or the gym if they're not eating. Their 1st period teacher will MEET THEM IN THE GYM on Monday only.
- **What time does my 6th grader need to be at school?** They are dismissed (after Aug. 5th) from the gym at 7:20 and must be in class at 7:30. Students coming into the office at 7:30 are marked tardy.
- **What time is my 6th grader dismissed?** Dismissal is at 2:35.
- **How does car rider line work for drop-off and pickup?** If coming from Main St. direction, you'll pass the main entrance and enter at the second entrance- stay in the left lane. If you're coming from the high school or Long Hollow direction, you'll turn into the first entrance- stay in the right lane. Cars slowly pull forward to the end of the awning (where the last front office window is located) and end the group where the sidewalk ends. **The adults will signal when it's ok for your 6th grader to get out of the car! Stay put and pull forward slowly only when the adults signal for traffic to move forward, and the next group of cars moves up.** (It's easy to change exit direction AFTER pulling out passed the building.)
- **What about bus riders?** Buses are on a tight schedule. Remind your student to move quickly at dismissal to catch the bus. Bus riders head down the hallway directly in front of the lobby.
- **What about lunch period?** The cafeteria employees and the staff will ensure your student makes it through the line or to their seat correctly.
- **What if my 6th grader has P.E. first semester?** Be sure your student has gym shoes, socks, and black shorts every day. P.E. shirts will be sold on Thursday for \$7- cash or check.
