This week we sent home individual student TCAP reports from the Spring 2018 TCAP Assessment. Please take time to look over these documents with your student.

I would like to highlight some of our school-wide accomplishments. In combined grades 6-8 ELA, math, and science achievement we are ranked second among traditional middle schools within our district. This puts our student achievement average well above our district and state in all three achievement categories. Our students and teachers worked tirelessly toward standard mastery in all content areas and we are very proud of the high achievement our students showcased on these assessments!

While our achievement ranking is high, we will be working diligently to increase our student academic growth rate from year-to-year. One piece of this process will be a defined focus on student goal setting. This process involves discussing and creating applicable individual growth goals, measuring success to either celebrate growth or thrive within the process of targeting specific standards-based needs, conducting individual/class reflections, and making individual/class instructional adjustments to help promote mastery.
